The Early History of TYC

In the early 1960s, a number of dedicated sailors who kept their boats at Beccue's Marina formed a sailing school for their children using two Sabot dinghies. This was the beginning of what we now know as the Tuscarora Yacht Club.

The TYC Island, formerly known as Wintergreen Island, was purchased by Red Clark in 1960 from the owners of a Victorian-style house that burned down in 1958. The former guesthouse of this home was a log cabin on the island.

Red moved the log cabin next to his tennis court and constructed a hot dog stand, miniature golf course, and forty docks on the island. Since the hot dog stand was not profitable, Red approached Bill Burhans, Dick MacFarlane, Merle Zehr, and Ray Capen with a proposal to rent the docks from him. In 1964, about twenty individuals left Beccue's and came to Wintergreen Island. These individuals legally incorporated the Tuscarora Yacht Club in 1968 and formally leased the island from Red. As TYC continued to grow, Red added more docks. Milt Ulrich initiated a social aspect for the club in the form of parties. Dick MacFarlane's daughter, Vicki, designed the TYC burgee.

In 1973, the original TYC stock corporation was reincorporated as Wintergreen Island Yacht Club—with principals Bill Burhans, Dick MacFarlane, Merle Zehr, and Ray Capen—to maintain the island as a place to keep boats for a reasonable cost. George McKinney proposed establishing TYC as a not-for-profit club. This change was accomplished by having the four principals of the Wintergreen Island Yacht Club lease the island to TYC for one dollar. The reorganized TYC required that all members place one year's fees into escrow to cover the succeeding year's lease cost and assure Red of continuity of payment.

From these humble beginnings, TYC has grown into the marvelous organization it is today.

Rules & Policies

GENERAL

First and foremost, this is your club; treat it as you would any of your other possessions. Remember, you pay for the privilege of your surroundings at TYC. If we all help to maintain the property, the cost of operations, and thus the cost of your dues and dockage, will continue to be among the lowest rates available.

All club members are responsible for doing their fair share to maintain the club property and/or to assist in club social events. Don't wait to be asked. Volunteer to the Vice Commodore for social events or the Director of Operations for grounds work. Remember that those who don't contribute cost us all, either in terms of reduced benefits or increased fees. Therefore, each full member of TYC and/or spouse will be required to spend ten hours of work per boating year performing service for TYC.

Board members will keep an ongoing list of items and jobs that need to be completed all year long on the TYC clubhouse bulletin board. Duties could be anything from planting flowers, helping with spring cleanup, chairing parties, cleaning up after parties, assisting with mowing, assisting with launch crew and haul out crew, painting, etc. The value of each hour of your work for the club has been set at \$20.00. Those not performing ten hours of work will be fined the per hour rate for the hours not worked after the work year ends, December 31st. (3/14/18)

RULES AND POLICIES

1. Club members are responsible for the safety and behavior of their families, guests and friends. The member is responsible for seeing that club rules are followed
2. All full docking members are responsible for their Officer-of-the-Day (O.D.) assignment. If you are unable to complete your O.D. assignment you can ask another member to fulfill your assignment, or hire an off-duty steward to replace you. You must notify the Director of Harbor Operations if modification to the schedule have been made. If you fail to complete your assignment, you will be assessed a \$50.00 fine. The OD schedule will be posted on the TYC clubhouse bulletin board, in the Steward's office and TYC website. You are required to sign in at the Steward's office on your scheduled date. (3/14/2018)
3. Every member (and his family, guests and friends) is responsible for cleaning up after themselves around their dock, and after using any club facilities. Boxes should be flattened before depositing in the recycling totes. (3/14/2018)
4. Trying to force the main gate is punishable by a \$25.00 fine plus repair cost. Be patient; a member will open it for you if you have forgotten your card.
5. We have limited space for members' vehicles. One vehicle per member is

permitted on the island. Members' vehicles should be parked on the landside of the island road, not on the waterside.

6. Vehicles of guests and friends must be parked in the upper lot outside the gate. (2016)
7. Traffic around the island is one-way, going counterclockwise. **The speed limit on the island is five mph. This rule is critical for the safety of children playing on the grounds and people walking on the street.** (3/14/2018)
8. All motorhomes, campers and any style trailer (boat, camping, etc.) must be parked in the upper lot.
9. Approved Dinghy's with trailers are allowed in the designated area of the island parking lot. (3/14/18)
10. No camping tents or motorhomes are allowed anywhere on the club grounds. (3/14/2018)
11. The stewards work for TYC and have their job assignments designated by the Director of Operations. They are not members' personal servants. They have been trained to be always helpful, co-operative and courteous to members and guests.
12. The kitchen is for use by club members and visiting boaters. If you use the kitchen, please leave it in better condition than you found it.
13. Pets must be leashed and kept out of the clubhouse and off the main patio of the Club house. Pets are permitted only on the visitor's patio at the southwest corner of the clubhouse. It is the owner's responsibility to clean up after their pet. Failure to comply will result in a \$25.00 fine. (3/14/18)
14. When cruising away from the club, either overnight or for extended periods, be sure to sign out at the steward's office, so that your slip will be available for guests in your absence and for your boat when your return. If you return earlier than planned, call the steward either by phone or VHF radio to be sure your slip is vacated before your arrival. The club monitors VHF Channel 68.
15. All cradles must be labeled with the owner's name, bow and stern identified, and slip number. Failure to comply results in a \$25.00 fine. (3/14/2018)
16. Spray painting of boat bottoms or topsides, in or out of the water, power sanding or media blasting without complete containment is prohibited on club property. This rule has been enacted by the Board due to the potential for liability to the club. Violation of this policy will result in loss of privileges for winter storage of the member's vessel for one year and/or a fine of \$500.00. A second violation will result in automatic revocation of your TYC membership. (3/14/2018)
17. The boat owner or his designated (in writing) representative must be present

for haul out, launch and mast stepping or un-stepping. Your boat and mast must be ready to go when the crane and crew arrive. The crane and crew will not wait for you to prepare; they will move on to the next boat/mast. If time permits, they will come back to you at their convenience; and you may be liable for additional crane and crew charges. Otherwise, you will be responsible for haul, launch or mast stepping / un-stepping at your own expense.

18. Boats without visible sling marks will not be launched or hauled out by TYC's crews.
19. For safety reasons, only the club crew may use the gin pole on designated launch, haul out, mast stepping and mast un-stepping days. Members may operate the gin pole on any other days providing they have taken training in its operation.
20. Winter-stored masts and all mast horses and/or storage supports must be removed from the island no more than one week from the date of launch. Any masts and materials that remain after that time will be moved to the upper parking lot by the club. A service charge of \$25.00 will be assessed to the member, and the club will not be responsible for any damage or loss to the member's property. (2016)
21. Any dock uprights that extend into the water must be removed by the slip renting member by November 15th in order to prevent ice damage to the dock. Members failing to do so will be assessed a fine of \$25.00.
22. In order to enhance the safety of the crane crew, no frames may be erected or masts stored on boat topsides before the boat is hauled. If you have stored your mast or erected a frame on your boat before haul-out or have not removed the mast or frame at launch time, you will NOT be hauled / launched.
23. New members desiring a dock box and members in need of replacing old dock boxes should use Rubbermaid or similar boxes of the 54 inch or less variety.
24. All trailers stored in the upper parking lot must be registered with the Fleet Captain. Trailer storage fees apply (see TYC membership cost). Trailers not registered may be subject to a \$25.00 fine and removal from the property at owner's expense. (3/14/18)
25. As a courtesy to other members and guests, proper attire should be worn in the clubhouse and patio areas. Shirts, shoes, and bathing suit coverings are required.
26. Members using the crane for haul out that do not store with TYC will be billed \$10.00 x the length of vessel to cover crane costs. This cost will cover crane charges to Haul and Launch a boat, not stored on the TYC club grounds. (3/18/18)

FUELING POLICY AND OPERATIONS

- a) Full members with assigned docks at TYC and Full members who are not docking at TYC are entitled to purchase gasoline at the club's gas dock at cost per gallon + \$.05 at the time of fueling.
- b) Full docking members may request a gas key if they desire.
- c) Reciprocal yacht clubs may be limited on the number of gallons purchased due to the availability of fuel at the time of purchase.
- d) Warning: Fueling of any size boat at member slips, or any site other than the gas dock, is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**. This includes, dinghies, jet skis, rowboats or pontoon boats. (3/18/18)

GAS DOCK SAFETY (2/24/18)

- a) Boats with internal fuel tanks and portable fuel tanks may be filled only at the gas dock.
- b) The club gas pump must be used to refuel, unless the amount of gas added is less than ten gallons using an approved portable container at the gas dock.
- c) Boats using diesel fuel may be fueled at the gas dock using an approved portable container. Boats requiring a large quantity of diesel, not suitable of fueling from a small container, should obtain fuel from another source in the harbor. (3/14/2018)
- d) Follow the steward's instructions when fueling at the gas dock. The Club has a large fire extinguisher adjacent to the fuel pump. **Know how to use it before starting any fueling.** Follow safe fueling practices, i.e. as outlined in *Chapman's*. Fuel shall be performed during daylight hours only. (3/14/2018)
- e) The operator is responsible to insure that NO spill of petroleum occurs during fueling operations. If spillage does occur, a Steward and Board Member must be notified immediately. The Club provides appropriate clean-up equipment which must be used to contain and clean-up the spill.

BEFORE FUELING SAFETY PRECAUTIONS (2/24/18)

- a) Make sure that your boat is securely tied to the fueling dock.
- b) Stop engines, motors, fans, and other devices capable of producing a spark. Open the master switch if your electrical system has one. Put out all galley fires and open flames.
- c) Close all ports, windows, doors and hatches so that fuel vapors or flames cannot blow aboard and below.
- d) Disembark all passengers and any crewmembers not needed for fueling operations.
- e) No smoking on board or in the vicinity.
- f) Have a filled fire extinguisher from your boat close at hand. Know how to use the large fire extinguisher located at the gas pump.
- g) Measure the fuel in the tanks and do not order or fill more fuel than the tank will hold; allow for expansion.

WHILE FUELING SAFETY PRECAUTIONS (2/24/18)

- a) Keep the nozzle or can spout in contact with the fill opening to guard against static sparks. Use absorbent pads around the nozzle during refueling. (3/14/18)
- b) Do not spill any gasoline.
- c) Do not overfill. Filling until fuel flows from the vents is highly dangerous.
- d) For outboards, remove portable tanks from your boat and fill onshore.

AFTER FUELING SAFETY PRECAUTIONS (2/24/18)

- a) Close all fill openings.
- b) Wipe up any spilled gasoline; dispose of absorbent pads properly onshore.
- c) Open all ports, windows, doors, and hatches; turn on the master electrical switch and bilge power exhaust blower. Ventilate the boat this way for at least five minutes. Time it; don't guess.
- d) Sniff low down in the tank and engine compartments. If any odor of gasoline is present, do not start your engine; continue ventilation actions until odor can no longer be detected
- e) Be prepared to cast off lines as soon as your engine starts; get clear of gas dock quickly.

SLIP ASSIGNMENTS

1. Slip assignments will be based on the boat's length, beam, draft and mast height with consideration being given for seniority (See Article 3 and Addendum 12) when more than one boat meets the slip requirements.
2. The Fleet Captain shall maintain a map showing the minimum and maximum boat size for each slip or group of slips in terms of length, beam, draft, and mast height if appropriate.
3. The Fleet Captain shall maintain a current slip request list and a slip change list of all members requesting a slip or a slip assignment change. These lists shall be ranked by seniority for the sole purpose of notifying interested members when an appropriate size slip becomes available.
(2/24/18)
4. If a slip becomes available at any time during the year, the details of the slip will be posted on the Club's Website and an Email notification will be sent out to all members. Available slips will be posted in the TYC clubhouse bulletin board between launch and haul out. The slip's availability shall be made available for a minimum of 14 days before an assignment is made by the fleet captain. The member will then have 7 days to accept or reject the offered slip. Any additional names that appear on these postings will be added to the slip Request list or the slip change list. (3/14/18)
5. A slip for a new member is temporary for a two-year period. During this period the board has the right to reassign that member to another available location that meets the requirements of his boat.
- ~~6. Temporary Slip fees for any member who does not have an assigned slip, whether or not paying Slip fees at another marina/club, will be charged at a rate of \$0.50 per foot per day.~~
7. If, for any reason, a slip is assigned to a member with a boat shorter than the designated minimum length for that slip, that assignment will be valid only for the first year and for one full year following, and the Slip fee will be for the designated minimum footage. If the member does not obtain a larger boat during that period, the Fleet Captain retains the right to reassign that member to a slip that more appropriately matches the size of the boat.
8. During the Fall Slip reservation period, reservation forms will be sent via email to prior season Slip holders. Reservation forms should also be used to communicate Slip change requests. Information will be added to the slip change list. (3/14/18)
9. A Slip Reservation Deposit is a formal request by the member to reserve his/her Slip for the upcoming year. The Slip Reservation Deposit is **non-**

refundable. Slip Reservations may be rescinded up to one week prior to launch. After that date, the member is responsible for the full assessed fee of the slip. (2/24/18)

10. Members wishing to keep their current slips for up to one year without using it, or that wish to forfeit their slip after launch, are required to pay the full assessed Slip fees due for that season. Notification must be made in writing of their intent to the Fleet Captain, whereby the Fleet Captain will make every effort to fill the slip with a new member, or a current member that is awaiting an assigned slip, at prevailing rates. The club will then reimburse said member for any and all extra Slip fees collected during the time from the new member or current member is in the slip. If full payment for Slip fees is not made, then per the By-Laws Addenda 3, (in part) the member is considered in arrears and membership is subject to termination.
11. The club cannot be held accountable for High lake levels effecting dockage. (3/11/18)

New Member Slip Fee Policy

For a new "Full" member that is assigned a Slip, Slip fees will be calculated as follows for the first year:

1. If seniority date is before June 1st, the full year Slip rate applies. (Length of boat times current Slip rate)
2. If seniority date is on or after June 1st, Slip fees will be prorated in the following manner:

Length of boat time's current Slip rate divided by total number of Slip days (Launch to haul out) equals daily Slip rate for that year. This daily Slip rate is then multiplied by the number of days left in the season starting with the 1st day that the Fleet Captain assigns a Slip to the day of haul out.

(Example – Length of boat 30', use current Slip rate per foot, in this example multiply by \$60.00 per foot which equals \$1800.00. If TYC launches on May 1st and hauls boats on October 1st this equates to 153 Slip days between launch and haul out. Divide \$1800.00 by 153 Slip days and the daily Slip rate is \$11.76. If a new member is assigned a Slip on June 10th by the Fleet Captain and the haul out is October 11th there are 112 days from that assignment to haul out, therefore the member would be responsible for 112 days times the daily rate of \$11.76 or \$1411.20.)

Also in accordance with Article 3, Section 10 of the By-Laws: Any member whose membership commences on or after August 1 will have their membership dues credited to the following year. (2/24/18)

FAQs

1. LIFE THREATENING EMERGENCY:

Call 911

2. OTHER EMERGENCIES (NOT LIFE THREATENING)

Notify stewards or any board member.

3. QUESTIONS ABOUT BILLS FOR DUES, DOCKAGE, STORAGE, FUEL, ETC.

Ask the club Bookkeeper or treasurer

4. NOT GETTING CLUB MAILINGS

Notify the Rear Commodore. Please supply name, address, zip code, email address and phone number.

5. EXPENSES BY MEMBERS ON BEHALF OF THE CLUB

All members seeking reimbursement for expenses from TYC must first seek approval from a Board Member prior to incurring the expense. This approval will be in writing using an "Expense Approval Request Form" from the steward's office. Please fill this form out and present it to a Board Member for approval. The approved form along with the receipts of incurred expenses (receipts) will be presented by the member to the Treasurer for payment.

6. REPAIRS

Lumber and fasteners for dock repairs will be provided by TYC. Carpet and extra cleats for the docks will not be paid for by TYC and are at your expense. For any repairs to the Club property please talk to the Director of Operations. For any repairs to the docks, electrical or water please talk to the Director of Harbor Operations.

7. DOCK ASSIGNMENTS

Contact the Fleet Captain for any questions regarding dock assignment. It is important to talk to the Fleet Captain before you buy a new boat. Depending on the boat's LOA, draft, beam, mast height, and owner's seniority, the club may not be able to accommodate you in a new slip.

8. OFFICER-OF-THE-DAY ASSIGNMENTS

Officer-of-the-day assignments are made before launch. If you can't meet your assignment, you may trade with another member or hire an off-duty steward to replace you. Notify the Director of Harbor Operations of problems in meeting your assignment or trades that you have made.

9. USING THE CLUBHOUSE FOR PARTIES

If you wish to use the clubhouse for a private party, you must get permission in advance from the Board of Directors. Allow at least one month's notice so the board can meet. The clubhouse is not available for private parties from noon Friday through Sunday night or on holidays from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

10. CLUBHOUSE AND GROUNDS MAINTENANCE

For physical problems in the clubhouse or around the grounds, notify the steward on duty. The steward will contact the Director of Operations. If the situation is serious, notify the Director of Operations directly.

11. PROBLEMS WITH PETS

Notify the pet owner. Pets must be leashed. Cleanup of waste is mandatory.

12. RECIPROCAL POLICY

The daily dockage rate is \$10.00 (U.S.) per night. Any single visit to TYC is limited to a maximum of three nights, unless a longer stay is requested and approved by a member of the Board of Directors.

13. MUFFLER POLICY

All boats docked at the club must have proper mufflers and not exceed the noise restrictions applied in NYS Navigation Law Section 44.

RESERVATION POLICY

Social events are an important part of the club's activities. It is the goal of the club to offer these events in a manner which will provide little to no burden to the club's yearly budget. When there is a cost to an event, planning requires that we set prices for those attending. This price setting covers the costs while keeping the price to members at a minimum. Event planners need to have an accurate count of those committing to attend. For that reason the club, when deemed appropriate, will post on the event announcement the term, "Reservation Policy in Effect". This means the following:

- 1. In order to complete your reservation for attending you must sign up and make full payment for the event prior to the deadline date.*
- 2. Cancellations with full refunds may take place when contacting the appropriate person prior to the sign-up deadline.*
- 3. Refunds will not be provided to those who cancel after the deadline date or fail to attend the event.*

By-Laws

Subject and pursuant to the provisions of the certificate of incorporation, the following shall be the By-Laws of the Tuscarora Yacht Club, Incorporated.

ARTICLE #1 – NAME

The name of this organization shall be the Tuscarora Yacht Club, Incorporated (Herein after referred to as “the Club”).

ARTICLE #2 – PURPOSE

To promote and encourage all phases of boating and water activities.

ARTICLE #3 – MEMBERSHIP

SECTION 1

There will be three classes of membership – Full, Social and Life.

A. Full membership:

1. Only full membership shall include the reservation of a boat slip.
2. Only full membership shall include voting rights and accrue or maintain seniority.
3. Full membership may revert to social membership in accordance with Article 3, 1. B.2 and Article 3, Sec. 7 and 9 and only upon request of the full member.
4. In the case of married couples, the privileges of full membership shall apply to both married partners, except that (a) they cast only a single vote at Club meetings, and (b) only one marital partner may serve as a member of the Board of Directors at a given time.

B. Social membership:

1. Social membership shall include all the social privileges of active membership.
2. Social membership shall have no voting rights nor accrue seniority.
3. In the case of married couples, the privileges of social membership shall apply to both married partners.

C. Life membership:

1. Full members, who have retired from boat ownership, and are at least 65 years of age, or due to health related reasons had to give up boat ownership, and have been a full member for at least 15 years shall be eligible for Life Membership status. Candidates will be nominated by the Board of Directors and elected to Life Membership by the Board of Governors.
2. Life members will be exempt from membership dues. Refundable initiation fees, paid prior to January 1, 1982 will be refunded.

SECTION 2

Membership shall consist of persons 21 years of age or over.

SECTION 3

Application for full or social membership in TYC, Inc. shall be considered only by presentation of a completed prescribed application form. The Board of Directors will exercise due diligence in assessing the personal background and individual character of new member applicants through the interview process, internet searches, and the occasional request of personal references. During the boating season, beginning with the day of the Spring Membership Meeting and ending with the final day of haul out, applications for membership will be posted on the TYC clubhouse bulletin board. During all other times, applications for membership will be posted in the newsletter, the TYC web site, and/or e-mailed to members. Members in good standing will then be given fourteen (14) days after posting to file any objections to the applicant(s) with the Board of Directors. After or during the posting period, applicants must appear before the Board for an interview at a time designated by the Board. The final decision for membership approval shall be up to the Board of Directors. (10/2014)

SECTION 4

Membership is vested in the individual, or in case of married partners, in the couple, and is not transferable; except, in the event of death of a member the surviving spouse shall retain membership and seniority.

SECTION 5

If for any reason membership should be terminated, a new application must be submitted to the Club and shall follow original application procedure, if reinstatement is desired.

SECTION 6

An initiation fee shall be charged all applicants accepted for membership by the Board of Directors. The amount of this fee shall be: For Full membership – \$500.00; for Social membership – \$350.00. This initiation fee is payable only upon acceptance into membership and is in no way to be construed as a yearly dues payment. At such time as a social member desires to change his or her membership to a full membership, the fee for full membership shall be reduced by the amount paid for social membership.

SECTION 7

Upon cessation of a membership for any cause, the membership shall be taken over by the Club. If there is indebtedness owing to the Club by the outgoing member it shall be payable immediately. Every membership is expressly subject to the provisions of this section.

SECTION 8

All fees and other charges mentioned herein are exclusive of taxes imposed by the Federal, State, and other Governmental bodies and agencies.

SECTION 9

Any member whose membership dates prior to January 1, 1982, upon voluntary surrender of a membership, with the Board of Directors' approval, will be reimbursed the initiation fee.

SECTION 10

Any member whose membership commences on or after August 1st will have their membership dues credited to the following year

ARTICLE #4 – BOARD OF DIRECTORS

(Hereinafter referred to as “the Board”). The Board shall be charged with the governing and administration of the Club. The Board shall consist of eight members, each to be elected by the membership, to a term of two years, limited to two consecutive terms. Elections to be held each year to fill four vacancies.

SECTION 1

The Board shall have charge of the affairs and properties of the Club: Shall elect members to the Club, and shall interpret in the light of their judgment the constitution and By-Laws of the Club.

SECTION 2

All temporary or permanent vacancies occurring on the Board shall be filled by the Board from the roll of membership and, may include either married partner, subject to the exceptions given in Article 3.1.A.4.

SECTION 3

The Board shall meet once a month and at such times as the Commodore deems necessary.

SECTION 4

Directors not able to physically attend a regularly scheduled meeting may participate via telecommunication (for example Face Time, Skype, etc.) Attendance in such a fashion would be acceptable for a maximum of three (3) regularly scheduled meetings per calendar year. A member attending in such a fashion would be counted in the number required to meet the defined quorum. Any member of the Board who shall absent himself or herself from a total of three (3) Board meetings in one (1) calendar year shall be deemed to have resigned as a member of the Board and shall cease to be a member thereof. (9/23/17)

SECTION 5

A quorum shall consist of four (4) directors and no business shall be transacted without said quorum.

SECTION 6

The Board shall keep an accurate record of its proceedings. All Directors shall turn over to their successor's in-office all documents, papers and other property belonging to the Club.

ARTICLE #5 – OFFICERS

SECTION 1

The officers shall consist of a Commodore, Vice Commodore, Rear Commodore, Secretary, Treasurer, Fleet Captain, Director of Operations, and Director of Harbor Operations. They shall be elected for a term of one year from within the Board and by the Board.

SECTION 2

Duties

- A. **Commodore** – Shall preside at all meetings of the Club and Board. Shall have authority to call special meetings of the Club and Board, shall have power to appoint, with the approval of the Board, the chairpersons of all committees and by virtue of office shall be a member of all committees.
- B. **Vice Commodore** – Shall assist the Commodore and shall execute the duties of the Commodore in the Commodore's absence or in case of a vacancy in the office of Commodore.
- C. **Rear Commodore** – Shall assist the Commodore and Vice-Commodore and shall execute duties of the Vice Commodore in the Vice Commodore's absence or in case of a vacancy in the office of Vice Commodore. The Rear Commodore shall initiate a quarterly bulletin to the membership throughout the calendar year. The Rear Commodore may increase the frequency of the bulletins if he or she deems it of benefit to the Club.
- D. **Secretary** – Shall send out the notices of meetings of the Club, keep the minutes, and attend to the correspondence pertaining to the office of Secretary.
- E. **Treasurer** - Shall be the financial officer of the Club and shall have custody of all dues and other moneys received into the Club. The Treasurer shall pay routine bills, such as utilities, contracted services, and taxes, when received. Shall pay all other bills as have been approved by the Board. Shall report all such payments at the next monthly board meeting. The Treasurer's records shall be absolute at all times and shall be readily available for inspection by the Board. The Treasurer's records shall be compiled annually by a C.P.A. The treasurer shall prepare and

present at the Annual Meeting, a detailed report of all financial transactions of the Club for a year. The Treasurer shall arrange necessary bonding as may be required by the Board of Directors for the safe custody of the funds of the Club. The cost of bonding to be borne by the Club. The Treasurer's records shall be kept in accordance with a generally accepted accounting procedure established by the Board. The Treasurer or Treasurer's designee shall deposit the funds, documents and other legal papers in the name of the Club, in a depository approved by the Board.

- F. **Fleet Captain** – Shall be in charge of all slip assignments. Fleet Captain shall be in charge of all activities concerning setting in and hauling out. He or she will be in charge of the work crews associated with the setting in and hauling out.
- G. **Director of Operations** – Shall be in charge of all activities concerning the maintenance of the Clubhouse and grounds. Director of Operations will hire and be in charge of the Steward program and will be our liaison with the owner for extensive repairs by the owner.
- H. **Director of Harbor Operations** – Shall be in charge of all waterfront activity. Shall supervise the Officer-of-the-Day Program (O.D.) and coordinate the repair of all docks by the owners and for the owners. Director of Harbor Operations will assist the Director of Operations in his duties whenever needed or directed.

ARTICLE #6 – MEETINGS

There shall be held no less than two (2) membership meetings a year. The annual meeting of the Club shall be held during the fall, within four (4) weeks of haul out, on a date and at a place to be specified by the Board. Notice thereof to be provided to all members by mail, no less than ten (10) days prior to the meeting. The spring meeting to be held in the spring of the year within four (4) weeks of Launch. Membership shall be notified of the meeting in the same manner as for the annual meeting.

ARTICLE #7 – ELECTIONS

SECTION 1

At least thirty (30) days before the annual meeting, the Commodore shall appoint one member of the Board of Directors not eligible for election to act as chairperson of a nominating committee who shall in turn select two members at large (not members of the Board) to serve with him or her as the nominating committee. The nominating committee will designate one of the at-large members as teller. No member of the nominating committee may be a candidate for election.

SECTION 2

Nominating committee will attempt to select a slate of at least six (6) candidates for vacancies on the Board. All candidates, in the year they desire election, shall be full docking members and must have been a member in good standing for the preceding (2) years.⁽⁰⁹⁻²³⁻¹⁷⁾

SECTION 3

The ballots issued to the membership shall be stamped. They shall be mailed by November 15th and returned to the designated teller by December 1st. Candidates' names will appear on the ballots in a sequence picked by lot.

ARTICLE #8 – THE CLUB YEAR

The Club year shall consist of that period between January 1st and December 31st. This shall include all business and fiscal affairs as well as membership.

ARTICLE #9 – CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

The Board shall not be empowered to undertake any encumbrances, mortgages, or loans without an affirmative vote of the membership.

ARTICLE #10 – AMENDMENTS

SECTION 1

Revisions or amendments to this TYC Constitution shall be brought forward at the regular Spring and Fall Meetings. Those revisions or amendments will be voted on by inclusion in the mailed yearly election ballots as specified in ARTICLE #7, SECTION 3. Approval shall require a two-thirds (2/3) majority of those responding, but not less than twenty percent (20%) of the eligible voting membership.

Revision or amendment to this TYC Constitution may also be made at a Special Meeting called for this purpose. A quorum of twenty percent (20%) of the eligible voting membership must be present. Approval of any revision or amendment shall require a two-thirds (2/3) majority of those present. Notice of such revision or amendment must be forwarded to each member at least two (2) weeks prior to, and not more than four (4) weeks prior to a regular Spring or Fall meeting. Notice may be made in the Club newsletter or by special notification, as appropriate. (09/19/15)

SECTION 2

There shall be a Club By-Laws Committee to review this constitution and to insure that it is current, and to evaluate any proposed amendments made by the membership. The committee shall be comprised of a minimum of three (3) full members, including the chairperson. The chairperson shall be a member of the Board of Governors and shall be appointed to a one-year term by the Commodore. The chairperson may serve additional terms when appointed by succeeding commodores. The By-Laws Committee shall present drafts of any recommended changes to the Board of Directors for its review and comment at a regular or special meeting of the Board. Board approval shall not be necessary for presentation of proposed changes to the membership as described in Section 1.

ARTICLE #11 – FINANCIAL COMMITTEE

There shall be a committee who shall be empowered on behalf of the Club to negotiate with the property owner/landlord all leases and in the event possible, to negotiate the possible purchase of all or part of what is commonly referred to as the "Tuscarora Yacht Club". This committee shall consist of the following full members in good standing: The current Commodore, immediate past Commodore (if so desirous), and two Board of Governors, and one or as needed member(s) designated by the current Commodore. The provisions of Article #9 shall apply in all instances.

ADDENDA

1. The committees of the Club shall be designated by the Commodore with the approval of the Board of Directors.
2. Conduct – Members shall be responsible for their own conduct and the conduct of their family and guests, and shall be accountable to the Board for any action detrimental to the Club or its membership. Any presentation of charges by one or more members to the Board, as to the misconduct of a member or guest of member, the charge or charges shall be taken into consideration by the Board for appropriate action.
3. All moneys due the Club are payable upon presentation of a bill, and the following actions shall be taken by the Board:
 - A. At the end of thirty (30) days the member is in arrears, his or her name will be posted on the Club bulletin board and or newsletter (electronic or otherwise).
 - B. All voting rights as a member are suspended and a member cannot run for office or hold any Club office during this period.
 - C. At the end of forty-five (45) days, an arrears member shall be sent a Postal Service Delivery Confirmation letter stating that his or her membership will be terminated if all moneys are not paid in ten (10) days and he or she will forfeit all initiation fees.
 - D. Under extenuating circumstances, by two-thirds (2/3) vote the Board may modify the above terms.
4. Each member shall be assigned to a committee or committees. Members are responsible to the committee heads for their fair share of the work to be done. Launch and haul-out shall be considered the responsibility of the individual owners and employees under the direction of the Fleet Captain.
5. Any rental, appropriation, assignment or use of the Club Facilities including docks, slips and moorings, shall be the exclusive prerogative of the Board. Such use shall be reserved for Club Members only.
6. Roberts' Rules of Order shall prevail at all meetings of the Club and Board.
7. Any member shall have the right to appeal any decision or ruling by the Board.

8. The annual dues for membership shall be determined by the Board of Directors with the approval of the general membership. The annual dues for membership shall be \$250.00. Dues are payable January 1st through January 30th; fifteen (15) days after final notice from the Secretary, membership will be terminated. Final notice to be mailed no later than February 10th.
9. Any issue requiring approval of the general membership shall be decided by an affirmative vote of a simple majority of those present, provided that notification of proposed issues is given at least two (2) weeks prior to and not more than four (4) weeks prior to said meeting.
10. The members of the Club shall not be subject to any assessment.
11. The Club colors are green and white; the Club emblem is a ship's wheel with the letters "TYC" printed inside.
12. For boats that are co-owned, the seniority will be based on the owner, partner, etc., who has the lowest seniority. Further, all owners, partners, etc., must maintain a full membership in the Club. The Fleet Captain and/or the Board are entitled to request current proof of ownership and insurance coverage from any member.
13. A Board of Governors chaired by the Commodore will consist of all Past Commodores who are still Full or Life members. The Board of Governors will function as an advisory panel to the Commodore. It shall meet a minimum of three times per year with one meeting scheduled approximately two months prior to the spring meeting, one meeting scheduled two months prior to the fall meeting, and a third meeting scheduled after the fall meeting. At the discretion of the Commodore additional meetings may be scheduled. (10/2014)
14. Dock reservations are due before November 15th. Reservations are valid only after membership dues and any other outstanding charges have been fully paid. On November 15th, all dock holders from the past year who have not at that time submitted their valid reservation and paid their dock deposits in full shall be notified by Postal Service Delivery Confirmation. Members will have fifteen (15) days from receipt of the notice to remit a valid dock deposit plus a \$25.00 late fee. Dock reservations received after the fifteen (15) day period will not be honored.
15. No member shall hold more than one slip per season. Under extenuating circumstances, by two-thirds (2/3) vote, the Board may modify the above terms.
16. The price of fuel shall be set at an amount not to exceed five (5) cents the cost paid at the time of delivery.
17. If mail notification to member(s) is required, email notification will be an acceptable method of mail notification. Upon member request, accommodations will be made for those members who do not have email. (09/19/15)
