


Tuscarora Currents

This year we will begin launching boats on Friday, April 30th with the operation continuing throughout Saturday, May 1st.

As soon as the clubhouse opens I will be posting sheets requesting volunteers for mast stepping, launch and cradle crews, so be watching for that. Working on one of these crews is a great way to get your work hours in, and meet other TYC members.

More information regarding launch details will follow at the spring meeting.

If a slip becomes available at any time during the year, the details of the slip will be posted on the Club's Website and an Email notification will be sent out to all members. Available slips will be posted on the TYC clubhouse bulletin board between launch and haul out. If a member would like to request a slip or request a slip change it is very simple. Just fill out the Slip Request / Swap Form on our website.

As in the past, those members wishing to store their dinghies in the parking lot must fill out the online Dinghy Reservation Form on our website. Note, we have 12 spaces available on a first come basis. There is no charge for dinghy storage.

Members may also store their boat trailers in the upper parking from May 1st through October 1st for an \$81.00 tax included fee. This request must be made by filling out the online Trailer Storage Request on our website.

I would like to thank those who submitted their dock reservation contract and proof of insurance certificates. If you have not done so please send them to me ASAP.
